


This equipment is designed to be professionally installed by an approved up-fitter. Always wear ear and eye protection and exercise caution when installing Westcan products.




PREPARATION:

- 1. Ensure all parts are present and accounted for before installation. **Install the over canopy rack** base plates on you vehicle before starting the assembly of your over canopy rack. Plan the location of your installation ahead of time and make sure your installation location does not impede any other components you are installing or damage the safety and functionality of your vehicle.
- 2. Exercise extreme diligence when drilling holes into a motor vehicle. Increasing complexity and model year changes can alter the location of fuel, hydraulic and electrical lines. Please visually inspect all locations prior to drilling.
- 3. Images used illustrate a typical installation. The parts in your specific installation may appear different but the installation procedure remains the same. Re-Torque all fasteners every **3 MONTHS if used on-road or every 1 MONTH if used off-road**.



2 X Passengers Side 2.




2 X Drivers Side



TOP TUBE MOUNTING HOLES ALL FACE THE OUTSODE OF THE LOWER LEG MOUNTING BRACKET

THE TOP TUBE MOUNTING SLEEVE SHOULD BE LEVEL TO THE BRACKET ON THE LOWER LEG WHEN PROPERY ORIENTED.

INSERT THE UPPER LEGS INTO THEIR CORRESPONDING LOWER LEGS.



REFER TO THE LAST PAGE OF THE INSTALL INSTRUCTIONS PROVIDED WITH THE OVER CANOPY RACK BRACKET GUIDE FOR THE FORWARD BAR MOUNTING HOLE LOCATIONS. SHORTER TRUCK BOX LENGTHS WILL REQUIRE THE FORWARD BARS TO BE CUT DOWN AND THE MOUNTING HOLE RE-DRILLED.
